## 2021 ISCB CONFERENCE FUND FOR DEVELOPING COUNTRIES

Financial support to participate in the 42nd Annual Conference of the International Society for Clinical Biostatistics is available to scientists and students from Developing Countries (Low, Lower-middle, and Upper-middle income economies, according to the World Bank list as of June 2020: <https://datahelpdesk.worldbank.org/knowledgebase/articles/906519-world-bank-country-and-lending-groups>).

In 2021, Conference registration fees will be waived for those selected for CFDC.

In order to qualify, applicants should submit an abstract for either oral or poster presentation and be selected by the Scientific Programme Committee (SPC) for presentation at ISCB42. Only original and unpublished work that has not been presented previously at a conference will be considered.

Applicants should indicate their request for consideration for the CFDC financial support at the time of abstract submission by checking the appropriate checkbox.

They should also send a letter of application on the official letterhead of the institution where the applicant is enrolled/employed to [cfdc@iscb.info](mailto:cfdc@iscb.info).

One award per author will be given, without transfer to co-authors. The awarded author's primary place of employment or educational institution must be in a Developing Country.

Please note that, as a general rule, the CFDC recipients from the previous conferences are not eligible to apply. However, as an exception, the recipients from the 41st (virtual) annual Conference (Krakow) are still eligible to apply.

The evaluation and selection for the CFDC will be based on the SPC's decision regarding the abstracts for oral/poster presentation. This will be administered by the CFDC Sub-committee comprising Tomasz Burzykowski (ISCB Vice-President) as Chair, and Elaine Pascoe (ISCB Secretary).

The CFDC will be entirely separate from the Conference Award for Scientists (CAsC) administered by the National Groups Sub-committee and from the Student Conference Awards (StCA) administered by the Student Conference Awards Sub-committee.

The closing date for applications will be the same as the conference general abstract submission deadline.
